
MINARET LAKE, MAMMOTH


TOPO map of the route:



We hiked over to the Devil's Postpile before starting on the Minaret Lake trail:



There is a lot of nice scenery in this area:



The Minaret Lake trail gains elevation rather quickly at the beginning, then levels out as it enters a valley and follows the Minaret Creek.



As we hike up the valley, we start to catch glimpses of the Minarets in the distance:



As we near the lake, we are hiking along Minaret Creek; it's a very nice creek, but there are numerous mosquitoes:



The lake is a welcome sight after the hike up here:



There is a trail which takes off to the north when hiking around the lake; I'm not sure if it's a shortcut to the Minaret Mine, or if it just leads to some more campsites:

Another panorama of the lake (note the overlap at both ends of the panorama):




