

Canyon Above Red Wall/“Rock Nettle” Canyon

The canyon starts out with low walls and a wide wash:



Early on there is a side canyon off to the left. We started up it on our way back:



Another side canyon:



Up ahead, we see that the canyon starts to narrow down:



Red colors on the canyon walls:



Up ahead we see what appears to be an impasse:



The first easy fall, and its bypass to the left:



The next (impassable) fall:



There was a bighorn sheep trail off to the left that attained the ridge, but it was steep and the talus was slippery. Also, it appeared difficult to get back into the canyon once on the ridge:



The second side canyon was narrower than the main canyon and had some nice colors in the walls and some interesting rock, before ending at a dry fall:





The second side canyon appears to continue uninterrupted for quite a ways:
