## **Undertaker Canyon**


Looking at the boulder jam from near Hole-in-the-Wall:

There is a boulder pile that must be climbed just after the second stage. Then, there is the third stage:




I found the fourth stage (which I didn't get a photo of) to be the most difficult because of the height, although the climbing itself was easier than that in the other stages. Entering the narrows:



9-foot fall in the narrows:








The canyon opens up after the narrows, and it is an easy walk in the wash to Widowmaker Dryfalls:
